WHEREAS, the Volcano Community Services District (District) was awarded grant(s) through Proposition 68, which is managed by the California Department of Parks and Recreation to update the Armory Hall, the public restrooms, and the town park; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Parks and Recreation approved applying the grant award for the town park towards the Armory Hall project; and

WHEREAS, the Volcano Community Services District published a Request for Bid in local newspapers with a submission deadline of December 11, 2025, at 6 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, as of 6 p.m. on December 11, 2025, (4) bids were received, (2) for the Armory Hall project and (2) for the public restroom project; and

WHEREAS, the Board opened and recorded the bids received at a public meeting held on December 11, 2025; and

WHEREAS, all bids received exceeded the Prop 68 grant funds awarded for both the Armory Hall and public restroom projects; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Volcano Community Services District that all bids received exceeded the awarded Prop 68 grant funds and are hereby rejected.
