**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-06**

**RESOLUTION OF APPLICATION BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE  
VOLCANO COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT REQUESTING THAT THE AMADOR  
LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION INITIATE PROCEEDINGS FOR A  
CHANGE OF ORGANIZATION TO THE AMADOR WATER AGENCY AND TO THE  
VOLCANO COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of the Volcano Community Services District (Volcano) proposes and requests that the Amador Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) initiate proceedings pursuant to Part 3 of the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, California Government Code Section 56650 et seq., to divest Volcano of its water production and distribution services, to extend water production and distribution services from the Amador Water Agency (AWA) to the existing jurisdiction of Volcano, a map of which is shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and to modify the jurisdictional boundaries of AWA to include the jurisdictional boundaries of Volcano, as that district is generally described on Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposal area consists of a total area of approximately 47 acres, the location and boundaries of which are depicted in Exhibit A and the boundaries of the Sphere of Influence are depicted in Exhibit B; and

**WHEREAS**, the reason for the proposal is:

In order to stabilize and ensure the economic ability of the district providing water and associated services to the jurisdictional area of Volcano, is it necessary that those services be provided by AWA rather than Volcano. Therefore, it is necessary to take possession and ownership of the water production and distribution facilities within the Volcano jurisdiction and to provide those services from AWA to the jurisdiction of Volcano, and to divest Volcano of its water production and distribution services; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposal is consistent with all relevant spheres of influence; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposal is subject to the following terms and conditions:

The proposal is contingent on the ability, both physically and economically, of AWA to adequately extend water production, distribution, and associated services to the jurisdictional area of Volcano, to adequately operate, maintain, and if necessary, improve, the water production and distribution infrastructure within the jurisdiction of Volcano, and to do so without adversely affecting the ability of AWA to provide those services to the remainder of its jurisdiction.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Directors of the Volcano Community Services District hereby proposes and requests that LAFCO initiate proceedings pursuant to Part 3 of the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, California Government Code Section 56650 et seq.

Upon motion of Alan Korematsu, seconded by Rebecca Korematsu, and duly carried, the Board of Directors of the Volcano Community Services District hereby approves and adopts this resolution on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of April 2026.

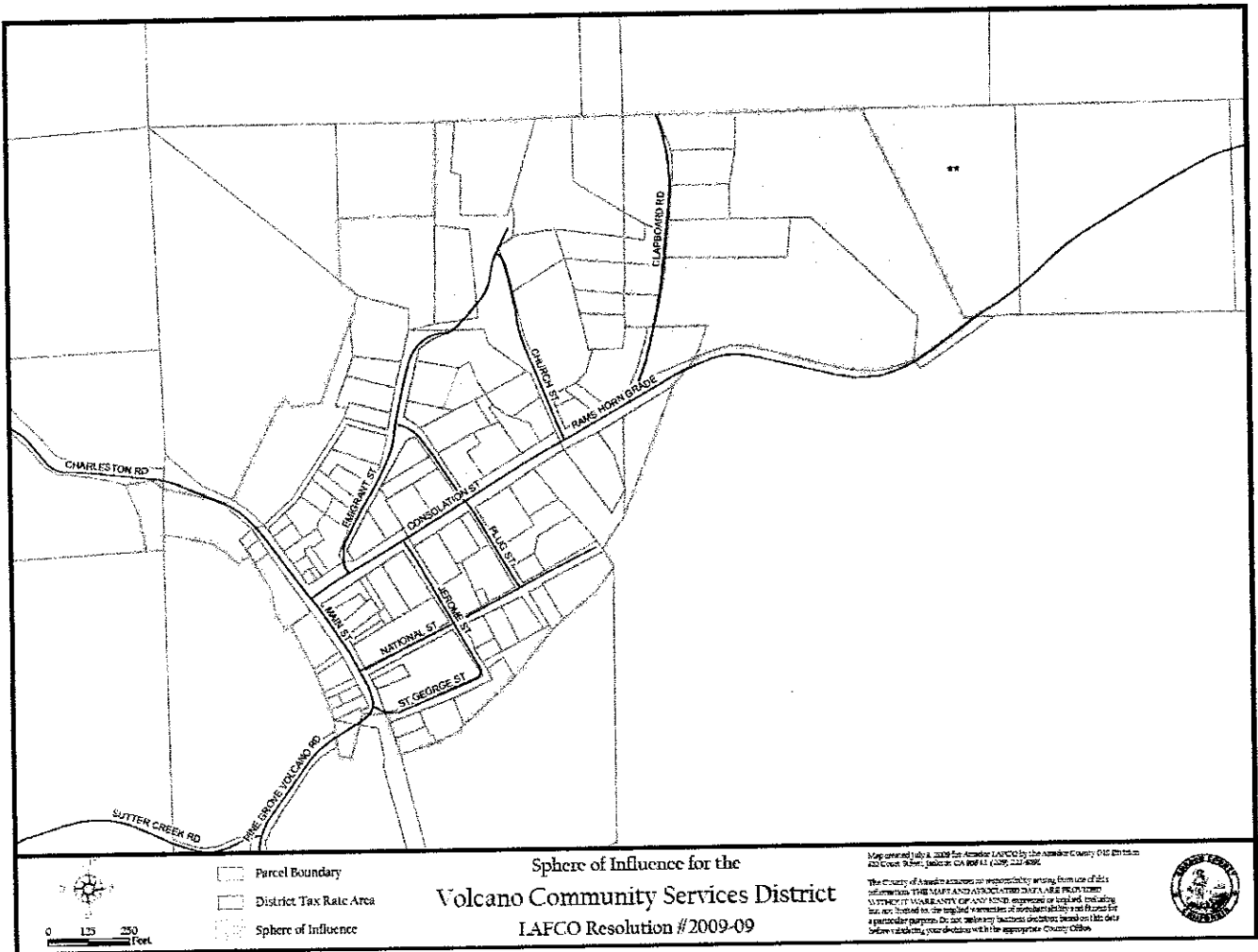
